House Wine

1. **Le Serin White, Cotes de Gascogne, France** £5.65 £22.50
Deliciously crisp and fruity with acacia flower aromas, green apple hints and a ripe gooseberry finish.

Crisp & Dry

2. **Paparuda Pinot Grigio, Timisoara, Romania** £5.70 £22.35
An enticing aroma of pears with hints of citrus fruit and a touch of honey. There is more ripe fruit on the palate with a refreshingly clean finish.
3. **Sauvignon Blanc, Pato Torrente, Valle Central, Chile** £5.70 £22.35
Zesty lime, juicy melon and ripe tropical fruit flavours. Lively, with good intensity and a well-balanced rounded palate.

Dry & Aromatic

4. **La Val Orballo Albarino, Rias Baixas, Spain** £8.70 £33.90
Orballo is what the Galicians call 'fine rain' – it turns out North West Spain is as wet as North Wales. The wine itself is full of peachy freshness and rainy minerality – delicious.
5. **Domaine Mas Bahourat 'La Petite Parcelle' Viognier, Gard, France** £6.55 £26.70
An intense aromatic Viognier produced from a tiny plot in the South of France. Classic notes of apricot and blossom jump out the glass.
6. **Villa Wolf Pinot Gris, Pfalz, Germany** £29.50
Made by renowned Alsace producer Dr Ernst Loosen. A stunning, off-dry and fruity white wine with a delicate acidity and honeyed notes on the finish.

Clean & Rounded

7. **Freedom Cross Chenin Blanc, Franschhoek, South Africa** £5.85 £24.50
Full, ripe apple fruit mingles with tropical flavours leading to a clean, dry finish. As ideal with food as it is without.
8. **The Cloud Factory Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand** £8.05 £31.95
Stunning modern Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Classic gooseberry and herbaceous characteristics meet lively peach and passionfruit notes.
10. **Sierra Grande Unwooded Chardonnay, Valle Central, Chile** £5.90 £24.60
A fantastic expression of unoaked Chilean mountain Chardonnay! Ripe white peaches and juicy pineapple on the nose with tight and structured mineral flavours on the palate.
11. **Pouilly-Fuissé cuvée Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Guerrin & Fils, Burgundy, France** £50.05
40+ year old chardonnay vines grown on limestone soils give impressive depth and intensity, and no little mineralité, supported by judicious oak: sweet white flowers, succulent peach fruit and more exotic notes besides.

12. **Gavi DOCG del Comune di Gavi, La Chiara, Tuscany, Italy** £35.50
 Immaculate, pure Cortese: fresh as a daisy and redolent of green apple, fruit blossom and honey. Well-structured with good richness and super length of flavour.

Fuller Bodied

13. **Clos de l'Eglise Macon-Charnay, Beaujolais / Maconnais, France** £35.50
 An unoaked White Burgundy from a single plot of old vines – a truly elegant high-end Chardonnay from one of the top villages of Macon.
14. **Sunnycliff Chardonnay, Victoria, Australia** £6.20 £24.80
 A fresh, medium-bodied wine with fruity characteristics of ripe peach and melon, rounded off with gentle oak. All that dry heat and sunshine from down-under create this stunner.
15. **Fiano, Carlomagno, Puglia IGP, Italy** £25.05
 Generous, aromatic style offering up notes of grapefruit, melon and banana. Nicely textured, plump and round with a lively sappy frame.

Sparkling

16. **Versetto Prosecco Extra Dry, Venetie, Italy** £5.75 £32.25
 Classic pear drop and floral notes in this incredibly drinkable fizz.
17. **Mas Macia Cava, Penedes, Spain** £31.50
 A fresh and creamy easy drinking Cava with complex flavours of apples and stone fruits and some nutty, yeasty notes from time on the lees. Good acidity and a long, savoury finish.
18. **Veuve Deloynes Tradition Brut, Champagne, France** £42.05
 Clean, fresh floral bouquet with a hint of hazelnut leading to a delicate yet refreshing citrus palate and a long balanced and rounded finish.
19. **Bollinger Special Cuvee, Champagne, France** £84.50
 Aromas of ripe fruit and spices joined by notes of roasted apple and peaches. The distinct golden colour with very fine bubbles will, on the palate, taste like velvet with flavours of pear, brioche and a hint of walnut.
20. **Nyetimber Classic Cuvee, West Sussex, England** £59.95
 English fizz?? Proper, Champagne-method sparkling wine from one of England's finest producers. Elegant lemon pastry flavours underpinned by a creamy texture.
21. **Rosè Vino Frizzante, Fabio Ceschin, Veneto, Italy** £26.95
 Produced in Prosecco country but from the lesser-known Raboso grape. Pretty, floral-tinged sweet berry fruit, fine mousse and a crisp savoury finish.
22. **Lallier Grand Rosé, Champagne, France** £75.00
 A boutique Champagne house sited in the same village as Bollinger. Lallier only use 'Grand Cru' fruit – the highest mark of quality in Champagne. This is a real treat.

A major crowd pleaser from the Sunshine State! Luscious strawberry ice cream on the nose supported by a bright, berry fruited palate and an off-dry finish.		
24. Terrazze della Luna Pinot Grigio Rosato, Trentino, Italy	£5.80	£23.05
Produced in a traditional method to extract the natural pinky bronze colour associated with Pinot Grigio – this is an elegant and dry rosé.		
25. Domaine de la Vielle Tour, Cotes de Provence, France	£8.95	£37.35
Lovely summery Provence. Elegant pale pink rose with strawberry notes and a refreshing finish.		
26. Whispering Angel, Cotes de Provence, France	£11.95	£46.95

A dark, brambly and delicious red from one of the best producers in the region, Borsao in Northern Spain. Great on its own or with food.		

Elegant, Easy & Soft

28. Merlot, Ladera Verde, Valle Central, Chile	£5.65	£23.50
Medium-bodied, round and juicy, with ripe plum, cherry and raspberry fruit. A short time in oak gives hints of wood spice, toast, roasted coffee and vanilla.		
29. Vega del Rayo Rioja Tempranillo, Rioja, Spain	£5.65	£23.50
A modern and vibrant young wine from Rioja Alta. All those familiar delicate tannins of Tempranillo, with plums and cherries balanced with a savoury earthy note.		
30. Paparuda Pinot Noir, Timisoara, Romania	£5.30	£21.50
A moreish, easy-drinking Pinot Noir, with lots of red cherry and raspberry flavours, interwoven with hints of savoury herb and spice		

Smooth, Silky & Earthy

31. Crozes-Hermitage 'Classique', Cave de Clairmont, Rhône, France		£38.50
Beautifully intense, perfumed Syrah full of peppery blackberry fruit, cassis, strawberry and violets. Silky and elegant, with great freshness and super concentration.		
32. Silver Myn, Stellenbosch, South Africa	£5.75	£23.65
A powerful and rich blend of Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon – think Bordeaux but with plenty of New World fruit. Brilliant value.		
33. Vallet Freres Bourgogne, Beaune, France		£42.90
Made the old-fashioned way, as it has for generations, from a small family concern in Beaune. Traditional wine making makes this old world Pinot Noir one for the purists.

| A ripe, smooth and characterful red from the South Rhone, a lovely example of this Mediterranean classic. | | |
| 35. Mr. Goose Shiraz, High Eden, Australia | £6.65 | £26.50 |
| Dark berry fruit aromas with hints of vanilla. Generous flavours of blackberry, plum and cherry. These are well balanced with coffee and caramel characters from the oak. | | |
| 36. Bacca Nera. Negroamaro Primitivo, Salento, Italy | £7.00 | £27.80 |
| A stunner from the heat of the heel of Italy. A lovely plummy character with soft, jammy tannins and an intense red fruit bouquet. | | |
| 37. Cline 'Old Vine' Lodi Zinfandel, Lodi, California, USA | | £34.05 |
| Classic and classy Californian Zin. French oak provides just the right amount of toasty vanilla character whilst the overtly ripe & luscious Zinfandel fruit makes this big & bold. | | |

| A full bodied, heavy style, deep garnet in colour with ripe berries and spice on the finish. | | |
| 39. Pinna Fidelis Roble Ribera del Duero, Duero, Spain | | £29.55 |
| We like to think of Ribera del Duero as a bolder, richer and punchier Rioja – a particular favourite of ours. | | |
| 40. Pablo y Walter Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina | £7.10 | £28.30 |
| A really pure expression of Malbec, deep red almost purple in colour and wonderfully aromatic with lifted violet, red currant and cassis notes. Muy, muy fantasticó – richly bloody, vibrant, and velveteen. | | |
| 41. Showdown Cabernet Sauvignon, California, USA | £6.95 | £27.80 |
| Ripe blackcurrant and wild berry fruit on the nose complimented sweet vanilla oak. Rich cassis and black cherry fruit on the palate with a soft, juicy, yet long finish. Framed by the subtle American oak. | | |
| 42. Riondo Amarone, Valpolicella, Italy | | £48.50 |
| This powerful wine is made using partially dried grapes from the Venetian hillsides which gives the wine its intense richness and full bodied flavour of prunes, chocolate and spice. | | |

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| 43. Ginestet Sauternes, France | 125ml | Bottle |

| A classic botrytis nose, gently floral and honeyed with hints of citrus marmalade. The palate is rich and smooth with flavours of barley sugar and bittersweet mandarin. | | |
